

More than a Change of Address Isaiah 7:14 with Matthew 1:18-25

It seems that the One who made us in His image is a person of and This is what the 1 st Christians
recognized about God—the way you know what He is doing is by seeing what He before and then noticing when it happens, usually in a greater, more impactful happening. The early Christians often observed something happening, noticed some past event or Scripture text like it and said, " is!"
Matthew tells us about the virgin birth of Jesus and says, "All this took place to what the Lord had said through the prophet." Regardless of the fulfillment of the prophecy, Christians saw the, and when Jesus was born in the way He was born—to an actual virgin—they said, "Aha, this is that!"
On the surface, the most stunning, dramatic part of the story is the idea that a gave birth to a son, and of course, it is stunning and dramatic. But the most, life-changing element in the connection between the Isaiah prophecy and the birth of Jesus is the name:, God with us.
This "with-us-ness" of Jesus is much more than a change of address. In Col. 2:12-14 Paul emphasized 3 ways in which we are with Jesus and He with us. We were with Him, with Him, and with Him. Here is the real glory of Immanuel. Not that God walked on earth 2000 years ago and ascended 33 yrs. later. It is that when you choose faith in Jesus as your Savior and Lord somehow,, you die with Him to an old way of life, with Him you are raised from death and now with Him you have a new life in which your sins are and your indebtedness to God is marked "!" Jesus jumped the chasm of time and eternity to be, making possible through faith in Him our death to the old life and resurrection to new life with a clean slate making possible a continuing with
