Ten-Day Forecast Revelation 2:8-11

The text today tells of a 10-day forecast given to the church of Smyrna. The predictions and instructions given to each church in Rev. 2 & 3 are intended to inform and guide
These verses warn believers about the difficulties that are to come when following Christ. Here is what Christians can expect: "Affliction," "poverty," "slander," "they are about to suffer," "prison," "testing," persecution," death."
Most believers have been influenced by some gospel teaching along with our natural human and conclude that if you have God on your side, you get to tribulation, illness, poverty, and suffering. We think, "Surely God rewards the faithful and punishes evil in this life. Poverty, slander, prison-these are the price of, not faithfulness."
There is good news. There is an on our time of struggle: "10 days." This number recalls Dan. 1:12 where Daniel is tested for 10 days and is proven Suffering for 10 days symbolizes any period a believer must endure the hardships of the world which, when they come to an end whether by or physical, the believer's faith in Christ will be proven right.
3 references in the text foreshadow the time when our faith will be proven right. 1 st , Jesus is called "the First and the Last." Jesus who created and will conclude this universe has never
