Something Bigger

Jeremiah 1:4-10

The Bible affirms that we _____ connected to something bigger than ourselves. This is confirmed in Jeremiah's call.

Right out of the gate, God reveals a stunning truth in **Jeremiah 1:4-10**. Before he was formed in his mother's womb, God already had something in mind for Jeremiah—a _____ and _____ for his existence. Jeremiah is part of something bigger—a _____ story. God is the _____ of this story in which we have been created and written into the narrative. If this is true, then there IS a _____ about your existence, about you.

It is fair to ask if Jeremiah's "word from God" can be applied to my life in any way. In fact, there is a theme in Scripture pointing to God's purposeful planning of not just prophets' lives, but of _____. The most dazzling, elegant expression of God's purposeful planning of each life, even before zygote divides, is found in _____ **139:13-16**. Likewise, _____ expressed the equal importance of all people in God's plan in **Job 31:15**, and _____ affirmed the same on multiple occasions.

Finally, there is _____ affirmation of the purposefulness of God in the life of every believer when he wrote in **Phil. 1:6**, "being confident of this, that he who _____ a good work in you will carry it on to _____ until the day of Christ Jesus." This led him to be able to tell the Ephesians, "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." This is not a word only for _____ and _____ but for _____ who turns to God in Christ to find their purpose—their place in God's something bigger.

At some point, you have or will have that nagging sense that you are in something bigger. This is God's "something bigger" and you were created to be a _____ part in it. Choosing to _____ is really the first step in accepting that God created you on purpose. You find that purpose by _____.
