

Something Bigger Joromiah 1:4-10

Jeremian 1:4-10
The Bible affirms that we connected to something bigger than ourselves. This is confirmed in Jeremiah's call.
Right out of the gate, God reveals a stunning truth in Jeremiah 1:4-10 . Before he was formed in his mother's womb, God already had something in mind for Jeremiah—a and for his existence. Jeremiah is part of something bigger—a story. God is the of this story in which we have been created and written into the narrative. If this is true, then there IS a about your existence, about you.
It is fair to ask if Jeremiah's "word from God" can be applied to my life in any way. In fact, there is a theme in Scripture pointing to God's purposeful planning of not just prophets' lives, but of
The most dazzling, elegant expression of God's purposeful planning of each life, even before zygote divides, is found in 139:13-16. Likewise, expressed the equal importance of all people in God's
plan in Job 31:15 , and affirmed the same on multiple occasions.
Finally, there is affirmation of the purposefulness of God in the life of every believer when he wrote in Phil. 1:6 , "being confident of this, that he who a good work in you will carry it on to until the day of Christ Jesus." This led him to be able to
tell the Ephesians, "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." This is not a word only for and but for who turns to God in Christ to find their purpose—their place in God's something bigger.
At some point, you have or will have that nagging sense that you are in something bigger. This is God's "something bigger" and you were created to be a part in it. Choosing to is really the first step in accepting that God created you on purpose. You find that purpose by
