

There is one way to correct the problem of fruitlessness. A branch produces grapes when it remains vitally connected to the vine. Jesus used the word the " " to describe our connection to Him. Do you know what will motivate you to live in Christ more than anything else? Attempting to Find where God is working and in His work.


